- Review recent updates in prostate cancer grading and reporting.
- Discuss diagnostic and management problems in breast core needle biopsies.
- Recognize important inflammatory and reactive lesions of the breast and their differential diagnoses.
- Summarize recent updates in thyroid pathology.
- Characterize the common elements of neuroendocrine neoplasia throughout the body.
- Summarize the spectrum of steroidogenic tissues and their tumors.
- Describe the common variants of ulcerative colitis and UC-related dysplasia.


